How to share your gps location using Google Maps and/ or Apple Maps

Sometimes 911 cannot locate you. If that is the case Do the following:

Using Google Maps:

- Get a phone number from the 911 operator that will accept a text.
- Tap Google Maps (teardrop symbol on your phone)
- Look for the blue bubble indicating where you are.
- Press and hold the blue bubble until the red teardrop mark appears.
- Look at the bottom of your screen where it says "Directions" and select the option to the right of it that says "share".
- Select the symbol that says "messages".
- The gps location will come up in the body of a text.
- Fill in the telephone number given to you by the 911 operator and press "send"

Using Apple Maps:

Get a phone number from 911 that will accept a text.

- Tap the Apple Map App symbol
- Press and hold the blue bubble indicating where you are until the red teardrop appears.
- A message will appear saying "my location". Below it tap "Send my location"
- Tap the symbol for messages and type in the tel number you want to receive the location.

In addition: It's OK to call 911, but in all EBRP call 510-881-1121 as well. They monitor this 24/7 and will know exactly where you are.
